TOURNAMENT RULES AND INFORMATION

Tournament to take place at Ring's Island Marina located at 14 First Street on Ring's Island in Salisbury, MA. For directions, please call 978-465-0307, email us at ringsisland@comcast.net, or visit our website at www.ringsislandmarina.com (you can also "like" us on Facebook!).

For bait and official weigh-in go to Bridge Road Bait and Tackle, Route 1, Salisbury, 978-465-3221. Inform them that you are participating in the Ring's Island Marina Striper Tournament. *(Be sure to "like" them on Facebook – a great resource for fishing updates!)*

Updates will be broadcast every hour on the hour throughout the day – tune in to Channel 7 on the two-way radio.

Fishing will begin at 7:00am (RAIN OR SHINE), Saturday, June 15th. All entrants MUST check in at Ring's Island Marina between the hours of 5:00am and 9:00am, prior to fishing.

The tournament closes at 3:00pm on Saturday, June 15th at which time Bridge Road Bait and Tackle will inform us of all winners. **All judges' decisions are final**.

Anglers may only enter only one striper to be measured. All stripers must be of legal size limit in order to be considered. All Striper must be fresh at the end of the tournament to qualify for measurement as determined by judges.

Striper will be measured from tip of tail to end of mouth. In case of a tie, the striper will be weighed and heaviest striper will win.

Grills and cooks will be available on-site at the post-tournament BBQ to grill your catch!

This **tournament is conducted on the basis of the honor system** and relies on the good sportsmanship of the registered anglers. Any participant caught violating the tournament rules will be banned from the tournament and will lose all eligibility for prizes. Committee reserves the right to exclude any individual/party who is deemed disruptive to the tournament or event.
